Attention: Non-Student Employees Currently Using Web Time Entry

As we begin to roll out the Banner functionality of Web Time Entry to our hourly employees, you will see additional codes appear on your BannerWeb timesheets. Under the heading "Earnings" you will see leave benefit codes that regular employees are eligible for. Until now all that was available to you was "Worked" and it was the only code that you could enter time for.

PLEASE NOTE that Banner WILL allow you to enter time using these new codes even if you are not eligible for benefit time. If you are a temporary or part-time employee not eligible for these codes, Banner will process NO PAY for these hours.

Please do not use these codes unless you are eligble to ensure that your paycheck is calculated

correctly.
