

**Buffalo artist Sczerbaniewicz 95 in High Strangeness exhibit**

Buffalo artist Gary Sczerbaniewicz, AU Class of 1995, will have a solo exhibition, "High Strangeness," at the Castellani Art Museum of Niagara University, Niagara Falls, from Sunday, Jan. 25 through Sunday, May 3, 2015. There will be an opening reception on the first day of the exhibit from 2-4 p.m. Admission is free.

An article in The Buffalo News reveals " 'High Strangeness' gives viewers a different perspective by featuring a series of small architectural vignettes that are viewed within a scorched periscope." The article goes on to say: "The artist calls the militaristic visions viewed in each periscope 'incursions' that transfer his psyche. The viewer cannot see what is revealed unless they are physically close to the peering site and dialogue can only take place under these intimate conditions."

Gary was the recipient of the Jacob Kassay Master of Fine Arts Award in 2013 and was a 2010 member of the New York Foundation on the Arts - Mark Program.
