The Lady Saxons (0-14, 0-2 Empire 8) lost the first game, 7-2, before dropping the nightcap, 9-0 in five innings. In the first game, senior shortstop Tara Harwood (Hornell/Hornell) and freshman leftfielder Rachel Porter (Almond/Alfred-Almond) each went 1-for-3 with an RBI.
