

AU men's basketball team drops one to Allegheny

MEADVILLE, PA The Alfred University men's basketball team lost on the road to Allegheny College, 85-62, Wednesday night. The Saxons (1-3, 0-0 Empire 8) struggled and shot 34 percent from the field in the first half but went in the locker room only down by three. In the second half, Alfred shooting woes continued and Allegheny pulled away to capture the non-conference victory. Leading the fight for AU was sophomore guard Chris Lemasters (Mansfield, PA/mansfield) with 17 points and eight rebounds.
