## Roundtable program to address 'Non-existence of Bisexuality in Fictional Media' 1/28/15

The first Women&s and Gender Studies Roundtable of the spring 2015 semester at Alfred University (AU) will be held on Friday, Jan. 30 from 12:20-1:10 p.m. in the Judson Leadership Center. AU student Lydia Galarneau will present on "Never Say Bi: The Non-Existence of Bisexuality in Fictional Media."
