

AU alumnus's work featured in summer/fall exhibit at Schein Museum

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Following graduation from Alfred University in 1993, James Klein, M.F.A., teamed up with high school friend David Reid and opened the KleinReid porcelain design studio in New York City. Their pieces are handmade and the porcelain and glazes used in their designs are hand-mixed. KleinReid's pieces can be seen on television, in movies, and have been featured in magazines like Vogue Living (Australia) and Elle Decor (South Africa). The duo will exhibit their work in the Schein-Joseph International Museum of Ceramic Art at Alfred University Wednesday, June 6 through Sept. 28, 2007. The gallery is open Wednesday through Friday, 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. Other upcoming events include a career conversation with Klein and Reid on Wednesday, Sept. 19 in Holmes Auditorium, Harder Hall, at 5 p.m. The event is sponsored by the Robert R. McComsey Career Development Center. There will be a reception with the artists on Thursday, Sept. 20 from 4:30-6 p.m. in the museum.
