ALFRED, NY "Artstream Nomadic Gallery," a restored 1967 Airstream travel trailer that has been converted into a showcase for art on wheels, will be on the campus of Alfred University from Sunday, March 25, through Tuesday, March 27.

Artstream, based in Carbondale, CO, has been a showcase for contemporary studio pottery for 17 years, making stops at locations across the country.
