## Foster Lake swimming suspended temporarily

Alfred University takes great pride in monitoring to assure the safest environment for all our students, staff, and visitors. To comply with standards set by the Allegany Department of Health and the NYS Department of Environmental Conservation, AU is required to conduct weekly tests for water quality in swimming areas that are open to the public, such as Foster Lake. In an effort to ensure safely at Foster Lake, we unfortunately have to prohibit swimming in the lake until further notice. Recently, the water quality has not met the requirements necessary for safe swimming. We will continue to test the water weekly.

As an accommodation to those who have purchased an access pass, we are opening the McLane Center pool. We hope it will create a swimming option for these very warm days ahead. We regret this situation and are working diligently to make sure Foster Lake remains a safe and enjoyable place. Camping, picnicking, hiking, and boating at Foster Lake are still possible. Thank you for your patience and understanding.

The McLane Center Pool will be open for Foster Lake Access Pass Holders according to the following schedule. Please be sure to present your access pass to the lifeguard when signing in.
