

AU men's swimming and diving defeat the RIT Tigers

ROCHESTER The Alfred University men's swimming and diving team defeated the Rochester Institute of Technology with a final meet score of 131-110 Saturday afternoon. A trio of AU competitors paced the Saxons (2-1, 2-0 Empire 8) effort with individual first and second place finishes and a first place relay finish. Senior Carl Schwarting (Weedsport/Weedsport) claimed first in the 100 freestyle and 400 freestyle relay, while earning second in the 50 freestyle. Junior Mike Dube (Williamsburg, VA/Lafayette) took first in the 1000 freestyle and 400 medley relay along with a second place finish in the 100 backstroke, while freshman Brian Gotham (Syracuse/Nottingham) added first place finishes in the 100 breaststroke and 400 medley relay and second in the 200 IM. Sophomore Kevin Martin (Conesus/Livonia) also added first place finishes in the 100 butterfly and 400 freestyle relay. Other second place finishers include junior Matt Weems (Arlington, VA/Washington & Lee) in the 200 and 500 freestyle events, senior Jack Stover III (Naples/Naples) in the 1000 freestyle, and junior Brendan Miller (Auburn/Auburn) in the 100 breaststroke. The AU team of Dube, Gotham, junior Bill Brown (Chaffee/Pioneer), and junior Matt McNamara (Livonia/Livonia) notched first place in the 400 medley relay, while the team of Martin, freshman Alex Crowell (Wayland, MA/Wayland), Weems, and Schwarting ended the meet with a first place finish in the 400 freestyle relay. The Tigers were led by Peter Kaemmerlen who finished first in the 200 and 500 freestyle events and also in the 200 IM. Alfred will next host Empire 8 rival Ithaca College on Tuesday, December 10th, at 6 p.m. in the Lebohner Pool.
