Freshman forward Alysha Dias (Rochester, NY/Greece Olympia) had 10 points and a team-high eight rebounds and senior point guard Meg Sampsell (Corry, PA/Corry) added 10 points and a pair of steals. Cortney Poirer led three Potsdam players in double figures with a game-high 17 points to go with seven rebounds and three steals.
