New EndNote users can download the software from the u:drive > Public > AULibraries > EndNote. Choose the folder of your operating system (Mac or Windows) and follow directions for install. EndNote makes setting up a bibliography or works cited page easy.

EndNote X4 for Mac will have a free update soon to solve incompatibility with Microsoft Word 2011.
