

AU Professor Travels to Alabama to Share his Knowledge and Experience

Alfred, NY -- Dr. David Kaplan, professor of education and director of Alfred University's graduate program in counseling, was a featured speaker at the recent 33rd annual conference of the Alabama Counseling Association in Birmingham. He presented a three-hour workshop on "Getting Started in Marriage and Family Counseling," which included a 45-minute demonstration with a family from the community. Also at the conference, he was the luncheon speaker for the Alabama Marriage and Family Counselors Association. Kaplan, who is president of the International Association of Marriage and Family Counselors, often publishes articles and speaks at professional gatherings about both counseling and the teaching of counseling at the college and graduate level.
