It is my distinct pleasure to invite you to attend the SUNY Lifesaver Program. This program is designed to comply with enactment of the state's AED legislation and to train University faculty, staff, and students in the skills of CPR and use of an AED.

This CPR/AED certification program has been approved by the NYS Department of Health. It is the equivalent to the American Red Cross and American Heart Association CPR/ AED programs. Upon completion you will receive a certificate that authorizes you to perform CPR on adults, infants and children.

EH&S is actively seeking volunteers for this program. At this time, anyone who wishes to participate and become certified is welcome to attend the training sessions. In particular, we need to have at least 3 volunteers from each floor in Binns Merrill Hall, Harder Hall and McMahon Engineering Building.
