

Alfred University volleyball team drops four at conference crossover

ROCHESTER, NY The Alfred University women's volleyball team lost all four matches played over the weekend at the Empire 8 Conference Crossover Tournament, hosted by RIT. The Lady Saxons end their season with a 7-20 record (0-7 Empire 8). On Saturday, AU lost to Ithaca 3-0 (30-17, 30-17, 30-24) and to Hartwick 3-2 (29-31, 30-26, 26-30, 30-23, 15-10). On Sunday, AU fell to Elmira 3-1 (30-32, 30-28, 30-20, 30-23) and to Utica 3-2 (30-25, 10-30, 30-26, 28-30, 15-7). Senior Catherine Rieck (Walworth, NY/Gananda) had seven kills and seven digs in the loss to Ithaca. Sophomore Stephanie Troiano (Clifton Park, NY/Shenendehowa) added three kills and eight digs while freshman Katie Lane (Edison, NJ/John P. Stevens) had four solo blocks. Against Hartwick, senior Beth Sanger (Greece, NY/Greece Arcadia) had 19 kills, nine digs and a pair of solo blocks to pace AU. Rieck had 11 kills and 10 digs and Troiano had seven kills and six digs. Senior Deen Genzardi (Oneonta, NY/Unatego) had six kills, 44 assists and four service aces; junior Sarah Berry (Mora, MN/Mora) had 12 kills and six solo blocks; and junior Corrine Wakeman (Marcellus, NY/Marcellus) added 11 digs. Sanger had 10 kills, eight digs and five solo blocks and Berry eight kills and seven solo blocks against Elmira. Genzardi added 24 assists and three kills, while Lane chipped in with three kills, 10 digs and six blocks. Berry had 13 kills and nine solo blocks against Utica. Troiano also posted 13 kills while adding three service aces and eight digs. Sanger had 10 kills, nine digs and four solo blocks; Rieck had 11 kills and nine digs; and Genzardi had 28 assists and six digs.
