

Alfred hosts HEOP leadership conference

Six universities from across New York State are expected to participate in the fourth annual Student Leadership Conference presented by the Higher Education Opportunity Program at Alfred University. The conference will be held this weekend (Nov. 11-13) on the Alfred campus. Registration for the conference will begin at 1 pm Friday 11 in the Knight Club. A dinner will be presented in Susan Howell Hall at 5 pm. On Saturday, the day will begin at 10 am with a presentation on "Multiculturalism in Children's Entertainment" by Dan Napolitano, director of student activities at Alfred University. At 11 am, the SHRM organization will present "How To Assert Yourself As a Diverse Leader." (Both of the preceding presentations will be held in the Olin School of Business, room 301.) At 1 pm, the conference resumes in Olin 302 with a presentation by the Poder Latino organization entitled "What Importance Does Leadership Have In Our Lives?" Kathy Woughter, acting vice president of Student Affairs, will discuss "Marketing Your Leadership Skills" in Olin 301 at 2 pm. At 3 pm, HEOP will hold an informational presentation entitled "HEOP Works" in Olin 302. Dinner is at 5 pm. The conference schedule for Sunday begins with an 11 am presentation entitled "What Would Leaders Do?" in Olin 301. This presentation is a production of the Caribbean Student Association at Alfred University. A brunch and subsequent closing remarks will be held at noon in Olin.
