Students' Rights under FERPA

Under the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA), students have certain rights with respect to their education record at AU. One of these is the right to block the release of "directory information."

Attached is a document that summarizes students' FERPA rights and provides a form that can be used to prevent release of directory information during the time you are enrolled at AU.

Please read the form carefully noting the consequences of blocking directory information and then, if you wish to keep the fact that you are enrolled at AU entirely confidential, sign the document and return it to the Student Service Center in Seidlin Hall.
