

AU women's soccer ends season with 1-1 tie

ALFRED, NY Alfred University women's soccer played their last game of the regular season Monday evening against visiting Buffalo State, ending in a 1-1 tie in double over-time. After a scoreless first half, Buffalo State netted the first goal of the game midway through the second half. AU answered just less than two minutes later when senior Ashley Van Wie (Gloversville/Gloversville) assisted sophomore Chelsea Hall (Elmira/Elmira Free Academy) for her team leading ninth goal of the season. Sophomore goalie Brianna Paquette (West Burke, VT/St. Johnsbury Academy) played the entire game in net for the Lady Saxons making ten saves and allowing only one goal. Jamie Abbott and Kaleigh Baker split time in goal for Buffalo State, recording one and six saves respectively. Gina Monaco scored the lone goal for the Bengals (6-10-2, 3-7-1 SUNYAC) on an assist from Missy Balling. Alfred finished the season with a 5-8-3 record overall and 1-4-2 in Empire 8.
