The Accident/Incident/Near-Miss form is to be used for anyone on campus including employees, students, or visitors.

Please fully complete the form that is posted on the EHS, Public Safety and Human Resources Web pages. Deliver All Accident/Incident/Near-miss forms to Environmental Health and Safety at haasec@alfred.edu or via confidential fax to 607-871-2086.

Do not delay when reporting accidents, incidents, or near-misses; all accidents, incidents, and nearmisses must be reported to your supervisor and EHS within 24 hours.
