Accident Reporting

Whenever an accident or incident occurs on campus (whether or not there are injuries/damages) it must be immediately reported to your supervisor and a report submitted to Environmental Health and Safety within 24 hours for follow up.

The goal is to ensure accidents and incidents are prevented in the future and through investigation, safety improvements can be made to activities, processes, or facilities.

The Accident/Incident/Near-miss form is required to be completed and filed for all accidents or near - misses on campus or (off campus) while participating in a University-sponsored program. The Accident/Incident/Near-Miss form is to be used for anyone on campus including employees, students, or visitors.

Please fully complete the form that is posted on the EHS, Public Safety and Human Resources Web pages. Deliver All Accident/Incident/Near-miss forms to Environmental Health and Safety at haasec@alfred.edu or via confidential fax to 607-871-2086.

Do not delay when reporting accidents, incidents, or near-misses; all accidents, incidents, and near-misses must be reported to your supervisor and EHS within 24 hours.
