AU outdoor track teams compete at Houghton

HOUGHTON, NY The Alfred University men's and women's outdoor track and field teams competed at Houghton College Thursday, each placing third of five teams competing. Senior Chris Clar (Rochester, NY/Gates-Chili) won the javelin throw with a heave of 47.54 meters. He also took fifth in the discus throw with a toss of 32.02 meters. Other top performers for the AU men were: freshman Matt Phillips (Kinderhook, NY/Ichabod Crane), third in the 200-meter dash (23.76 seconds); freshman Lee Consolo (Pleasantville, NY/Pleasantville), second in the 400-meter dash (51.78 seconds); senior Travis Swan (Binghamton, NY/Binghamton), second on the 800-meter run (2:06.50); senior Brendan Hill (Belfast, NY/Cuba-Rushford), third in the 400-meter hurdles (1:01.55); and sophomore Ryan Squillacioti (Smithtown, NY/Hauppauge), second in the shot put (13.24 meters). The AU women's team was paced by freshman Lana Placek (Niagara Falls, NY/Niagara-Wheatfield), with wins in the 400-meter dash (1:11.55) and pole vault (2.13) meters), and senior Kristen Egan (Robesonia, PA/Conrad Weiser), with a victory in the 5,000-meter run (19:41.51). Other top performances on the AU women's team were turned in by sophomore Megan McKee (Rush, NY/Rush-Henrietta) and freshman Megan Crimmins (Big Flats, NY/Horseheads), second (5:19.84) and third (5:20.51), respectively, in the 1,500-meter run; sophomore Kathryn Northup (Canandaigua, NY/Canandaigua), third in the 100-meter hurdles (19.39 seconds); freshman Rachel Gaylord (Elmira, NY/Horseheads), third in the 400-meter hurdles (1:15.66); and junior Catherine Hoffman (Belmont, NY/Genesee Valley), third in the javelin throw (25.75 meters).AU is in action next on Saturday, April 21, at Nazareth.
