

AU's Keeley named ECAC Northwest Offensive Player of the Week

ALFRED, NY Alfred University senior quarterback Paul Keeley (Caledonia, NY/Caledonia-Mumford) has been named the Eastern College Athletic Conference (ECAC) Northwest Region co-Offensive Player of the Week. Keeley was honored for his play in Alfred's 45-21 victory at Norwich Saturday, when he completed 23 of 28 passes for 290 yards and three touchdowns. He established a new AU career record for passing yardage (5,722) with the performance and also set a new standard for single-game completion percentage (82.1 percent). Both records had been held by 1984 AU graduate Glenn Law. The Empire 8's leader in passing efficiency (208.7), Keeley has thrown for 1,130 yards, 12 TDs and only one interception in four games this season. He has also completed a league-leading 73.5 percent of his passes. Keeley shares this week's ECAC Northwest honors with Hartwick quarterback Jason Boltus. AU and Hartwick meet this Saturday, Oct. 6, at 1 p.m. at Alfred.
