

Bode performs, exhibits at Norway festival

Peer Bode, professor of video arts and co-director of the Institute for Electronic Arts in the School of Art & Design at Alfred University, was invited to share his work and perform at the annual Punkt Festival in Khristiansand, Norway, earlier this month.

Bode, who is considered to be a “video pioneer,” showed his video arts and new media art works for two days on a continuous loop in one of the small cinema theaters connected with the festival; delivered a lecture at the Punkt Seminar, and gave two performances of his piece “Hermes.”

The festival (<http://punktfestival.no/>), now in its 10th year, focuses on the “interplay between music, visuals and literature.” It began as an experimental music festival, and has evolved to include other art forms.
