cattle and government property, and send an
Inventory to this Office
- 3* You will call for tenders for the supply of
one thousand bushels of Barley or Oats -
according to the conditions annexed, and
will open the tenders at a specified time -
You will not divulge the offers therein con-
- tained - but will forward all the tenders
to me with your recommendations - You
will particularly inquire into the solvency
of the sureties -
- 4* You will take every opportunity to keep me
informed of the state of your command
