To Sub-Inspector Frechette

ANSWER.

- 1 You are sent to Carlton to relieve Inspector Craigie, and take command of the Detachment there.
- 2 You will take over all stores, Horses and cattle and Government property, and send an Inventory to this Office
- 3 You will call for Tenders for the supply of one thousand bushels of Barley or Oats - according to the conditions annexed, and will open the tenders at a specified time - You will not divulge the offers therein contained - but will forward all the Tenders to me with your recommendations - You will particularly inquire into the Solvency of the Sureties -
- 4 You will take every opportunity to keep me informed of the state of your Command
