

Canadian ceramist to exhibit at Museum of Ceramic Art

A one-person exhibition, Singular Abstractions: Absolutely Recent Ceramics by Lopold Foulem , will be on view Jan. 25-April 5 at the Schein-Joseph International Museum of Ceramic Art at Alfred. A public reception will be held from 5:30-7 p.m. Feb. 8 at the Museum. The artist will be present at the opening reception to present a gallery talk. For Foulem, the one-person exhibition marks a return to Alfred and to the Schein-Joseph Museum. The Canadian ceramist delivered the third annual Dorothy Wilson Perkins Ceramic History Lecture, sponsored by the Museum, in October 2000. The Museum is located on the second floor of the Ceramic Corridor Innovation Center on Route 244 on the northern edge of the Village of Alfred. Admission is free.
