

Purple/Gold Days set to welcome accepted students

Alfred University will welcome accepted students and their families to campus this spring on two Saturdays, March 31 and April 14. The Admissions Office will host "Purple and Gold" activities from 8:30 a.m.-4 p.m. on each day. Registration begins in Harder Hall lobby followed by a welcome in Holmes Auditorium. At 9:30 a.m., the group breaks up for four separate sessions by various deans and an academic overview. These include sessions for: College of Liberal Arts and Sciences, Nevins Theatre, Powell Campus Center (PCC); College of Business, Olin Building; Inamori School of Engineering, McMahon Building and Seidlin Hall Annex; School of Art & Design, Holmes Auditorium, Harder Hall. Beyond Academics begins at 10:45 a.m. featuring an Athletics Fair in the Kenyon Allen Room, second floor, PCC; Student Organizations, the Knight Club, third floor, PCC; Student Services, Board Room, second floor, PCC. A Faculty Fair begins at 11:30 a.m. on the third floor of the Miller Performing Arts Center, followed by lunch for all at 12:30 p.m. in Ade Hall. Beginning at 1:30 p.m. there will be concurrent sessions - Campus Tours, departing from Ade and Alumni halls; a Residence Life Showcase; Equestrian Center Open House; and Stull Observatory Open House.
