The Rev. John Maxson's parents came from England and were the earliest settlers of New England and also among the first who attempted a landing on the shores of Connecticut. The party with which they were connected made a temporary settlement, it is supposed, near Throg's Neck, hence for some time after called Maxson Point. They carried on a trade with the Indians, and prospered until about the time of the breaking out of the Pequot War, in 1637, when the Indians who surrounded them, instigated probably by emissaries from the Pequods, suddenly abstained from intercourse with the settlers. Upon their sending to the natives to inquire why they did not come in as usual to trade, they received answer that they feared dogs, which they allowed to go unconfined, but that if they would shut them up they would come again. The unsuspecting colonists, blinded by their apparent good will, complied with the conditions, and their watchful sentinels once confined, the savages made an attack on the settlement and drove the whites to their shallop. A portion of them landing in a boat the next day to procure more provisions and produce from their gardens were again attacked and Richard Maxson and his son Richard were killed.

Mrs. Maxson escaped with the survivors in a shallop and after a long and tedious passage landed in the Island of Aquidneck, the nearest place on the coast at that time, free from the danger of the hostile Indians, where soon after her son, John, was born. This was in the spring of 1638. As the Island was purchased from the Sachems, Manitoumah and Canonicus on the 24th of March of that year, and settled by the English immediately thereafter, Mrs. Maxson remained there and devoted herself to the support and education of her son. John has the distinction of having been the first white child born on the Island. We regret that we do not have more of this Christian mother and heroine.

Under date of Feb. 2, 1639 the following entry appears:-- "Richard Maxson, blacksmith, upon complaint made against him was accordingly detected for his oppression in the way of his trade - who being convinced thereof, promised amendment and satisfaction."

On May 16, 1639 the new town of Newport was laid out and Richard Maxson was invited to join the group as blacksmith. It is evident that he accepted as his name appears on the first list of freemen. Also, he had 36 acres allotted to him.

In 1642 Richard Maxson sold his land at Portsmouth, including his home, to William Roulston, and removed to Long Island. There is some supposition that he may have been in the Hutchinson party. Ann Hutchinson, widow of William also went to Long Island in 1642.

At the time of his removal to Long Island Richard Maxson's family consisted of himself, his wife Rebecca, his son Richard age about 13, a daughter Rebecca probably about 11 and John b in 1638.

Several years after Richard Maxson's death (which is often erroneously given as 1638), that is, later than 1647, his widow, Rebecca, married John Harndell. Richard Maxson's death occurred in the Indian attack in 1643. There has been considerable confusion regarding the children of this Maxson family...but there seems to be no indication that Rebecca Maxson Harndell had any family by her second husband, John Harndell.

Additional information on this Maxson family indicates that Richard Maxson was admitted to the Church of Boston on 2 August 1634. He was at that time a journeyman blacksmith with James Everell.

It is interesting to note that Ann Hutchinson arrived in America and also in Rhode Island at about the same time that we first hear of Richard Maxson. Both were in the party that was killed in the Pequot uprising at Throgg's Neck, N.Y. in 1643. Supposition suggests a possible tie-in or close connection between the Hutchinson and Maxson families. It would be indeed helpful if proof or disproof of this supposition could be found.

Since the publication of the last issue of "Your Ancestors" a number of facts have been brought to light concerning the early history of the Maxson family which show that many misleading and erroneous statements have been made which have tended to confuse the issue, and with the hope of bringing order out of chaos, we submit the following data obtained through very careful search and containing documentary evidence. Also to bring out the fact that because of the apparent intimacy and closeness with the Hutchinson family, there must have been some relationship between the two families" even though it was before coming to America.

Richard Maxson was admitted to the Church in Boston October 2, 1634, with his wife Rebecca. Ann Hutchinson and her party came to Boston on the ship "Griffin" in 1634. It is possible that Richard Maxson came on the same ship.

In March 1638 Ann Hutchinson, who had been banished from the Massachusetts Colony because of her religious beliefs, took her family and went overland to Providence, R. I. William Coddington, Dr. John Clarke, John Coggeshall and possibly also Richard Maxson, were also banished from the colony for their 'pestilent heresy'. They seem to have made their way around Cape Cod and up Narragansett Bay to Providence where, with the aid of Roger Williams, they purchased the Island of Aquidneck.

The building of Pocasset (Portsmouth) began Mar. 24, 1638. Their avowed object was "to lay the foundation of a Christian State where all who bore the name might worship God according to the dictate of their consciences, untrammeled by written articles of faith and unawed by civil power".

Richard Maxson was a blacksmith. Bayle says, "Blacksmiths were then factors of great importance. They held a monopoly of work that was vitally necessary, and the colony might suffer from the abuse of any power that they held. It was, therefore, a proper function of the Court to prevent any excessive charges being made by the blacksmith whom the little colony had encouraged to settle in its midst". He not only cared for their horses' needs but also kept their arms shipshape and in repair. Whether it was prosperity or the lack of it that went to his head, Richard Maxson became one of the first "profiteers" when he decided to raise prices. This immediately met with popular disapproval. As a result his name appears on the Court Records as follows: Feb. 2, 1639--"Richard Maxson, blacksmith, upon complaint made against him, was accordingly detected for his oppression in the way of trade,- who, being convinced thereof, promised amendment and satisfaction".

William Coddington had been chosen Judge at Portsmouth but the minority party headed by William Hutchinson, Ann's husband, put Mr. Coddington out and elected Hutchinson in his place.

Ousted from Portsmouth, Coddington established a plantation at Newport. These men, William Coddington, Nicholas Easton, John Coggeshall, William Brebton, John Clarke, Jeremy Clarke, Thomas Hazard, Henry Bull, all Elders, and William Dyre, Clerk, comprised all the members of the Pocasset government. They carried off the records of the colony with them.

Deprived at once of their government and their records, those left at Pocasset decided to reorganize, and two days later, April 30, 1639, they formed a new compact, binding themselves to the following written agreement: "We, whose names are under, acknowledge ourselves the legall subjects of his Majestie, King Charles, and in his name doe hereby binde ourselves into a civill body politick and doe submit unto his lawes according to matter of justice". Twenty-nine names are signed, including that of Richard Maxson, thus choosing to remain with Ann Hutchinson. Many of these twenty-nine became ancestors of branches of the Maxson family.

The Newpost colony, confronted with the urgent need of a blacksmith, invited Richard Maxson to join them. That he did so almost immediately is evident from the fact that his name appears in the list of freemen at the settlement of the town, and that he shared in the original division of the land, having 36 acres allotted to him. The deed to this land is recorded on page 24 of Volume I of Land Evidence.

An old map in the Town Clerk's office at Portsmouth indicates that Richard Maxson also owned land in that settlement, located on the northwestern shore of the island, within the limits of what is now Lehigh Hill Park.

On October 1, 1639, Richard Maxson's name appears again in a "catalog of such persons who, by the general consent of the Company were admitted to be inhabitants of the Island now called Aquidneck, having submitted themselves to the Government that is or shall be established, according to the word of God therein".

In 1642 William Hutchinson died and Ann moved with her family to Long Island, later establishing a home on the mainland, on the shore of what is now Pelham Bay. Here in August or September 1643, she and all but one of her household were massacred by Indians.

In 1642 Richard Maxson sold land at Portsmouth, including his home, to William Roulston, according to Portsmouth records. He too went to Long Island, perhaps in the Hutchinson party, accompanied by his wife, Rebecca, his son Richard then 13, daughter, Rebecca, perhaps about 11 and John whom we know was born in 1638 just after the family landed on the Island of Aquidneck. The two older children must have been born in England. Tradition in the family says that the settlers were driven from their homes by an Indian uprising and many were killed. The rest took refuge in a shallop. The next day Richard Maxson, his son Richard and another son landed to get food and supplies for those who were marooned in the boat, and were massacred by Indians. His wife and two children, Rebecca and John, escaped in the boat. They finally reached Newport where they found sanctuary.

On May 20, 1644, Richard Maxson's widow, designated merely as 'Goodwife' Maxson, gave Roulston a receipt acknowledging payment for the property. It is evident that he had not received cash for his home at Portsmouth when he sold it in 1642.

Most of the confusion regarding the time of Richard Maxson's death seems to have come from the statements in the Diary of G. G. Richardson, Dec. 20, 1720 (Newport Historical Soc.) in which he recorded the date of death of Richard's son, John. This date, Dec. 20, 1720, is correct, also the date of John's birth--"soon after landing at Aquidneck" (1638). What he did was confuse that landing in Rhode Island with the later landing at Throgg's Neck, N.Y. in 1643, when Richard and his son Richard were killed.

Several years after Richard Maxson's death, certainly after 1647, his widow, Rebecca, married John Harndell. There has been a glorious mix-up over 'your children and my children' ever since. The facts are that there were no children of this second marriage. John Harndell's will dated 2-9-1685-pr.1687, proves the utter fallacy of these statements.

John Harndell had by his first wife Sarah _____, a daughter, Mary b. 7-6-1647, d 1678. She married Capt. John Stanton (1645-1716), son of Robert. Their children were:

There has been almost as much confusion about the early Moshers as there has been about the Maxsons. Much of it has been caused by confusing the Rev. Hugh Mosher, Sr. with his son the Rev. Hugh, Jr. It has been stated, on what appears to be good authority, that the Rev. Hugh, Sr. was son of Stephen of Manchester, England. There seems to be no evidence that the Rev. Hugh, Sr. ever lived in Rhode Island, but was at Saco and Falmouth, Maine, and was first in Salem, Mass. His son, the Rev. Hugh, Jr. was born in 1633 and married Rebecca Maxson, dau. of Richard and Rebecca.
