AU cross country teams each place 12th at state meet 11/05/05

CLINTON, NY The Alfred University men's and women's cross country teams each placed 12th Saturday at the New York State Collegiate Track Conference (NYSCTC) championship meet, hosted by Hamilton College. The AU men's team placed 12th of 16 teams competing. The top runner for Alfred was junior Travis Swan (Binghamton, NY/Binghamton), who finished the eight-kilometer course in 25th place with a time of 27:22.10. Sophomore Fontana Fluke (Shaftsbury, VT/Mt. Anthony Union) was 42nd in 27:41.30, while seniors Jason Belt (Potsdam, NY/Potsdam) and Jeff Norton (Buffalo, NY/St. Francis) were 82nd (28:53.70) and 83rd (28:54.00), respectively. The AU women placed 12th of 17 teams competing on the five-kilometer course. Freshman Krista Volloman (King's Park, NY/King's Park, OH/Alliance) was Alfred's top women's runner, placing 30th in a time of 19:15.00. Junior Kristen Egan (Robesonia, PA/Conrad Weiser) was right behind in 31st place with a time of 19:15.90. Junior Kate Ciccone (Brooktondale, NY/Ithaca) was 62nd in 20:08.90. Alfred's men's and women's teams are in action next on Saturday, Nov. 12, at the NCAA Atlantic Regional Championships at 11 a.m. (women) and noon (men) at the University of Rochester.
