Two returning Alfred University students were selected this spring to receive the fifth annual Sharon Hoover Fiat Lux Fund Award.Jasmine Reese, a junior English and communication studies major from Saratoga Springs, will be managing editor of the Fiat Lux, the University's student newspaper, next academic year. She served as news editor for 2007-08.Tom Fleming, a junior communication studies major from Penn Yan, is the incoming Fiat editor. He served as a copy editor last year. The Hoover Fund honors Dr. Sharon Hoover who advised the Fiat Lux for 15 years prior to her retirement.
