

Elmira knocks off Alfred University in Lady Saxons ♦ season home finale

ALFRED, NY Elmira College defeated the Alfred University women's basketball team, 72-54, Saturday afternoon in Alfred's final home game of the 2004-05 season. Junior forward Meg Coddington (Amherst, NH/Souhegan) paced AU (5-17, 1-11 Empire 8) with a game-high 18 points and 11 rebounds. Senior guard Michelle Kelly (Levittown, NY/Gen. Douglas MacArthur) added 10 points, making three of five shots from behind the arc. Sophomore guard Denae Foster (Canaseraga, NY/Arkport) added six points and three steals, while junior center Kylee Knoll (Elmira, NY/Elmira Free Academy) chipped in with five points, five rebounds and a pair of blocked shots. Senior center Jackie Seroka (Oyster Bay, NY/St. Dominic's) led Elmira (8-13, 3-8 Empire 8) with 15 points, seven rebounds and three blocks. Junior guard Sarah Cote (Windsor Locks, CT/Endfield) had 11 points and six rebounds, while senior guard Monica St. Croix (Watertown, NY/Immaculate Heart) pitched in with nine points, six rebounds and three assists.
