

## **AU men's basketball team stumbles in Elmira**

Elmira, NY The Alfred University men's basketball team lost on the road to Elmira College, 64-46, Saturday evening. The Saxons (3-20, 2-10 Empire 8) started the game by holding Elmira to fewer than thirty percent from the field. In the second half however, the Soaring Eagles almost doubled their percentage for a 46.7 percent second half. The Saxons hung around for one half of play; but the presence of Elmira guard Albert Davis proved to be too much, as he grabbed 20 rebounds to go along with fourteen points. Saxon freshman forward Dillon Stein (N. Huntington, PA/Norwin) had another impressive performance with a game-high 22 points to go along with twelve rebounds (7 offensive). Sophomore forward Nick Andolina (Arkport/Arkport) chipped in with ten points. He also recorded five boards and had two blocks. Sophomore guard Chris Lemasters (Mansfield, PA/Mansfield) had nine points as well to go along with a block and a steal. The Saxons are in action next at home against Nazareth on Feb. 20 at 8 p.m.
