

AU men's soccer sweeps Pitt-Bradford 5-0

ALFRED The Alfred University men's soccer team (3-5-1, 1-2 Empire 8) played a solid game against Pitt-Bradford College defeating the panthers 5-0 Wednesday evening on Merrill Field. The game remained scoreless until five minutes before the end of the first half when senior midfielder Jim Carroll (Buffalo/Bishop Timon St. Jude) netted a goal off of an assist from freshman forward Austin Lozier (Vestal/Vestal) to put the Saxons on the scoreboard leading 1-0. The second goal for Alfred came twelve minutes into the second half when junior forward Keith Phelan (Baldwin/Baldwin) fed sophomore midfielder Stephen Robin (Foster, RI/Ponaganset) lifting the score to 2-0. Senior midfielder Karl Gnann (Holley/Holley) scored the third goal of the game, which was unassisted three minutes after the previous goal was made. Freshman forward Anes Osmic (Rochester/Wilson) notched the fourth goal with 30 minutes remaining while freshman midfielder John Ninos (Alfred/Alfred-Almond) headed the ball into the net off of an assist from freshman defender Adam Wentlent (Tonawanda/Kenmore East) with seven minutes remaining in the game to secure the victory for AU. Senior Kevin Ball (Wheeling, WV/Linsly School) and freshman William Brown (Woodbury, VT/Hazen Union) managed the shutout for the Saxons. Bryan Grande was in goal for the Panthers notching three saves. Alfred will next be in action Saturday, Oct. 5 at 1 p.m. as the Saxons host Nazareth College.
