AU softball team splits doubleheader at Fredonia, ties wins mark 4/27/09



FREDONIA, NY - The Alfred University softball team beat host Fredonia 14-2 in five innings Monday afternoon to salvage a split of a non-conference doubleheader. The victory was Alfred's 24th of the 2009 campaign, tying the school single-season record for wins set last year. Fredonia took the opener, 1-0. Freshman pitcher Nicole Hedrick (Albany, NY/Catholic Central) earned the complete-game win for Alfred, allowing two runs (one earned) on two hits and striking out three to improve her record to 6-2 on the season. She helped herself at the plate, hitting a three-run homerun in the Saxons' five-run first inning. She added an RBI single in the second and finished with two hits and four RBIs.Junior third baseman Jesika LeBarron (Campbell, NY/Corning West) was 3-for-4 with a double, two RBIs and two runs, and junior second baseman Karen Folts (Penn Yan, NY/Penn Yan) had two hits and drove in three runs. Junior centerfielder Jessica Figallo (Ridgewood, NJ/Ridgewood) and junior shortstop Samantha Rollins (Hornell, NY/Hornell) each scored twice for the Saxons, who improved to 24-6 with the win. LeBarron's three hits give her 50 for the year, a new AU single-season record. Her double gives her 12 for the season, which ties a school mark. LeBarron and Rollins each tied the school single-season record for runs scored (29). In the opener, Fredonia scored the game's only run in the fourth inning when Katie Turvey hit a two-out double, advanced to third on a wild pitch, and scored on an error. Sophomore pitcher Chelsey Cary (Corfu, NY/Pembroke) was the hard luck loser for Alfred, going the distance and allowing an unearned run on four hits while striking out five and walking one. Folts went 3-for-3 to pace the Saxons' offense. Jennifer Tighe earned the win for Fredonia (15-20-1), allowing five hits and waling none. The game marked only the second time this season Alfred has been shut out. Alfred wraps up its regular season with a 3 p.m. doubleheader at Keuka College Wednesday, April 29. The Saxons then play in the Empire 8 Conference championship tournament Friday and Saturday, May 1 and 2, at Ithaca College. AU is the third seed in the doubleelimination tournament and opens play Friday at 10 a.m. against second seed St. John Fisher. The winner of the tournament earns the conference's automatic bid to the NCAA championships.
