

Alfred University men's basketball team falls to visiting Geneseo

ALFRED, NY -- The Alfred University men's basketball team lost to visiting Geneseo, 70-51, Tuesday night at the McLane Center. The Saxons (1-5, 0-0 Empire 8) shot 31 percent in the first half and trailed by 11 points, 32-21, at intermission. AU shot well in the second half (46 percent) but couldn't catch the visiting Knights (5-2), who shot 44 percent for the game. Alfred outrebounded Geneseo, 37-30, but was hurt by 15 turnovers. Freshman forward Dillon Stein (North Huntingdon, PA/Norwin) led Alfred with 12 points, five rebounds, three blocks and three assists. Sophomore guard Bruce Nober (Lake Huntington/Narrowsburg) had eight points, while sophomore guard Chris Lemasters (Mansfield, PA/Mansfield) chipped in with seven points, four rebounds and three assists. Ben Schwenebraten paced Geneseo players with a game-high 21 points to go with six rebounds. Steve McDonnell and John Kleis (game-high seven rebounds) scored 16 and 15 points, respectively. Alfred is in action next on Friday, Dec. 12, at 8 p.m. at home against Potsdam. The Saxons take on visiting St. Lawrence at 3 p.m. Saturday, Dec. 13.
