





I have not followed the side branches of the Greenman Family. Only

The first Greenmans in America appear in Taunton, Mass.in the Colony of New Plymouth. As early as I626 there were settlers in Taunton. Plymouth, the first English Settlement, was made in I620. From Plymouth, the Colonist drifted into New Plymouth. The greater part of the proprietors came in I637 to I639. In I639 Taunton was incorporated. In I640 Captain Miles Standish surveyed and layed out the town. It was named Taunton from Taunton, Somersetshire, England evidencing that influential members of the Colony came from that locality. Among the earliest proprietors appear the name of David Greenman. He was a land owner previous to I639 when the record shows that he disposed of his rights to James Tisdale.

John Greenman came to Dorchester, Mass.from Somerset, Wiltshire, England in 1630. Admitted an inhabitant of Newport, R.I. May 20th 1638. Listed as one who had large houses or otherwise serviceable. Had land assigned to him. Afterwards gave up as did others a portion of his land to constitute a public park or common. He also shared in the partition of the Islands in Narragansett Bay, Jamestown and Hog. Old records mention sale of lot 100 on ye point bounded East by Benj. Coggeshall, West on the harbor, North on Daniel Ayrault, South on Samuel Holme Mentioned as a hood-maker to Job Carr, a cooper of Newport. Also as an orginal purchaser of Taunton, Mass.

John's son, Edward Greenman, along with David Greenman were listed as wleel wrights. They sold twenty two acres of land near Endship or Village of Greenend on the highway leading from newport to Portsmouth. In 1655 he was enrolled as a freeman. In 1657 he was a commissioner. On Sept. 9th 1661 he had a quarter share of Misquamicut (Westerly) lands assigned to him. In 1668-1669-1670 and 1682 he was a deputy. In 1680 He was taxed I pound, Io shillings and 8 pence, about four dollars and thirty three cents. In 1678 he petitioned the assembly relative to the estate of George Brown, praying that a commissioner would declare the estate bankrupt. In 1688 he was foreman of the grand jury. His home was in Newport, R. I.

Edward's son, Thomas Greenman, was an original member of the Westerly Sabbatarian Church. He was a tailor and kept his own sheep, having an ear mark granted to him on Oct. 17 1700. On Oct 4th 1706 he sold 13 acres of homestead to Geo. Babcock of Westerly for 6 pounds, about eighteen dollars.

Sylvanus Greenman, son of Thomas and Mary Greenman, inherited land in South Kingston when his father died in 1728.

Deacon William Greenman of Stephentown, N.Y., son of Sylvanus and Sarah Greenman, was born in 1737 or 1738 probably in South Kingston, R.I. On Nov. 27 1760 he married Susannah Gardner. During the Revolution, William served as a private in Colonel Beekman's Fourth Regiment of Enlisted Men, Albany County, New York Militia.

Deacon James Greenman of Stephentown, N.Y., son of William and Susannah Greenman was born Jan. 15 1771 in South Kingston, R.I. His father moved to Stephentown, N.Y. soon after James was born. He married Lois Mason on Nov. 14 1793. Their children were Jesse Mason Greenman born on Feb. 24 1796. Alonson was born Jan. 23 1799. Lois died March 29 1802 when Jesse was 6 years old and Alonson was three. On July I 1802, James married Susannah Greene. James died at the age of 42 years on Nov. 28 1813.

Jesse Mason Greenman, son of James and Lois Greenman, and a great great great great grandson of John Greenman, was born in Stephentown, N.Y. He married Elizabeth Remington of Hancock, Mass. on July 12 ISIS. He moved from Stephentown to Berlin, N.Y., then to Almond, N.Y. and then to Alfred, N.Y. Later he settled on Greenman Hill in Hebron Township, Potter County, Pa.in 1831. That section of the country known as Greenman Hill was

named after Jesse Mason Greenman and his sons, James, William and Sylvester who all had farms there.

Jesse Mason Greenman bought IOO acres of unimproved land on Greenman Hill.He built a log cabin of hand hewn logs and it had an ash floor that his wife, Elizabeth, kept as white as marble.He died in I878 of a disease of the heart.

Greenman Hill was covered with virgin Pine.Lumber was of little value so it was burned to clear the land.Deer,bear,wolves,fox and wild turkeys were plentiful.Obtaining a living from the soil was difficult and often they would have gladly exchanged a platter of sliced turkey meat for a loaf of wheat bread. The nearest source of supplies was Jersey Shore.Roads were little better than trails and it was the usual practice to make the trip to Jersey Shore with a yoke of oxen, taking about a week to make the trip.An emergency trip for medicine could be made on horse back in much less time.

There was no water at the house site of my grandfather, James R. Greenman. They had to carry water from a spring some distance down the hill. One night my grandmother, Fanny Babcock Greenman, Went down to the spring to get a pail of water. It was dark and when she got back near the house, she saw what she thot was a bear and threw the pail of water at it. It turned out to be an old stump. so she had to make another trip back down to the spring.

The Greenmans were instrumental in building the Seventh Day Baptist Church at Hebron, Pa. It was completed Sept. 23 1869. The first officials were Jesse Mason Greenman, James R. Greenman, W. C. Reynolds, W. H. Hydorn,

George W.Stillman and Silas S.Greenman.

The following statement was written by Benjamin Franklin Greenman,

son of James R. Greenman.

"This Bible, the first ever owned by Miss Mary Anne Greenman, was given by her to her younger brother, Silas S Greenman when he was about to go to Oberlin, Ohio to school in his 18th year. By him it was used in his school room. When I, as a boy and his oldest nephew, looked to him many many times as a kind and practical teacher. Uncle Silas S. Greenman died April last aged 38 years at the home of his sister, Mrs. Mary Anne Stillman and today she gave me this Bible as a momanto.

Hebron, Potter County, Pa. 12th Sept. 1875.

B.F.Greenman"

Silas S Greenman served 3 years in the Civil War. He was in Company H. 71st N.Y. Infantry. He died in 1875 of wounds he received in the Battle of Gettysburg.

Mary Nichols' parents both died when Mary was an infant. Mary Anne and George Stillman took Mary and raised her. They did not adopt her. When grown Mary married Arch Tracy. They had two children named Theron and Mildred who married a Mary. Mary Anne lived with Mary Tracy the last few years of her life and died at Mary's Home. Mary Anne had a spirit lamp that originally belonged to Jesse Mason Greenman. After Mary Anne died, Arch Tracy gave this lamp to The Potter County Historical Society, Coudersport, Pa. where it is on display.

JOHN GREENMAN was born in Somerset, Wiltshire, England. He was the first Greenman in our line to come to America. He came to America in 1630. He Came to Dorchester, Mass. but was a resident of Newport, R. I. in 1638.

William Greenman served in the Revolution as a private in Colonel Beekman's Fourth Regiment of Enlisted Men, Albany County, New York Militia so any female member of the Greenman Family from here on down the line is eligible to join the DAR.
