The Hornell Art Walk will be an exciting exhibition of work by more than 50 artists throughout downtown Hornell. It will take place Saturday April 30 from 4 to 8 p.m.

The Hornell Art Walk is a collaboration between Alfred University's Space and Place class (which has been working in Hornell since January), The Hornell Community Arts Center, other students and faculty of AU's Sculpture/Dimensional Studies Division, the City of Hornell, and artists and organizations working in Hornell. The Art Walk features site-specific installations, exhibitions, open studios, and activities for the whole family.
