Did you know that one in every three women has been abused worldwide? And that 3 women a day are murdered by their significant other?

Accord Services of Allegany County offers a domestic abuse shelter for abused women; they also

provide services to help women get past these traumatic experiences and on to living a fulfilled and productive life at no cost.

In collaboration with Alfred University and the Women's Leadership Academy, a series of events called "When push comes to Shove" will take place to educate the community more about domestic violence and relational abuse. On Friday, March 25 there will be a "packed picnic basket" silent auction to raise money for Accord's domestic violence services. I'm requesting that students, faculty, clubs, and any individual interested assist with creating a picnic basket to be auctioned off.
