

'Seats of Power' to be discussed at Bergren Forum

Donald Royce-Roll, professor of art history at Alfred University, will present "Seats of Power: Mario Prisco, 20th Century Dean of Art School and Henry of Blois, 12th Century Bishop of Winchester," on Thursday, Feb. 14 2008, at the Bergren Forum at 12:10 p.m. at Powell Campus Center's Nevins Theatre. Admission is free of charge and open to the public. The presentation will be an argument that the key to understanding the medieval English bishop palace lies within the blueprints of Harder Hall, a building on the Alfred University campus. Royce-Roll earned a bachelor of science degree from the University of Nebraska; a master of arts degree from Michigan State University; and a Ph.D. from Cornell University. The Bergren Forum, sponsored by the Alfred University Division of Human Studies, meets Thursdays during each academic semester at the University. Participants are encouraged to bring lunch; coffee and tea will be available.
