

AU women's lacrosse team fall to Hartwick

ALFRED, NY The Alfred University women's lacrosse team fell to conference rival Hartwick 12-7 Saturday afternoon. In the first half, Alfred (2-8, 2-4 Empire 8) stayed within reach, with the score 5-3 half way through; but then the Hawks proceeded to score three unanswered goals to close out the half. In the second, AU equaled the goal production of Hartwick, but it was too late and the Lady Saxons could not make up the difference. Alfred was led by seniors Chris Sanford (Bowdoinham, ME/Mt. Ararat) and Kelly Farrell (Meriden, NH/Kimball Union) who both had three points, with three goals and one goal and two assist, respectively. Senior Katie Haarmann (Ridgewood, NJ/Ridgewood) continued to shine, scoring two goals and also recovering eight ground balls. Katie Ratchuk (South Buffalo/Mt.
