Business Office:

July 7th - All transactions such as corrections, transfers, budget adjustments, year-end accruals, etc. submitted for fiscal year 2016-2017.

Office & Procurement Services:

May 26th - All requisitions are due for fiscal year 2016-17.

June 30th - All Merchandise must be received for fiscal year 2016-17.

Accounts Payable:

June 30th - All merchandise and services must be received and invoiced to the University for fiscal year 2016-17.

July 7th - The cutoff date for travel expense forms that account for travel through June 30th for fiscal year 2016-17.

July 11th - Invoices for fiscal year 2016-2017
