

AU Announces Appointment of Assistant Professor of Biology

Alfred, NY -- Dr. William M. Hall, dean of the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences at Alfred University, announces the appointment of Dr. Cheryld L. Emmons as assistant professor of biology. Emmons earned her doctorate in horticulture science/plant breeding and genetics in 1996 from the University of Florida. She received a Master of Science degree in plant physiology in 1984 from Bowling Green State University and a Bachelor of Science degree in biology, with a minor in chemistry, in 1981 from Siena College. Since 1997, Emmons has worked as a post-doctoral research associate and plant physiologist with the U.S. Department of Agriculture in Madison, WI, conducting research on cereal crops. Her work involved analysis of antioxidant components of oats and barley. Emmons also worked as a physical science laboratory technician for the USDA; was a graduate assistant in the Horticulture Science Department at the University of Florida, and was an instructor in biology at Manatee Community College in Venice, Fla.
