### Alfred University Policy regarding Drone purchases

Did you know that the operation of drones and other small unmanned aircraft is regulated by the FAA and New York State law? As a result, Alfred University has a Drone Policy that governs the purchase of unmanned aircraft systems and their usage on campus. All requests to purchase drones must go through the purchase order process and be approved by the Drone Flight Review Committee (DFRC). A university one-card cannot be used when purchasing drones.
