Added to the College of Engineering and Professional Studies were: Dr. J. Steven Mayes, assistant professor of mechanical engineering. Mayes was a research assistant, instructor, and teaching assistant at the University of Wyoming from 1995-99. Since 1986, he has also worked for Carderock Division, Naval Surface Warfare Center, Virginia, where he was manager, principal investigator and lead engineer on numerous projects in the Structures and Composites Department.
