

AU's Kerwin earns honorable mention All-American status at NCAA championships

OXFORD, OH -- Alfred University senior Pat Kerwin (Canandaigua/Canandaigua) finished in ninth place in the 100-yard backstroke Friday during the NCAA Division III championship meet.
