Anthony Union), fourth in the 5000-meter run (16:07.61), junior Nate Corney (Walworth, NY/Gananda), third in the 55-meter hurdles (8.21), senior Randy Clukey (Bath, ME/Morse), fifth in the high jump (1.67 meters), freshman Doug Fertig (Marlboro, NJ/Marlboro), fifth in the pole vault (3.80 meters), senior Casey Lesar (Mechanicville, NY/Mechanicville), fifth in the triple jump (12.61 meters) and junior Rich Coyne (Scarborough, ME/Scarborough), sixth in the 200-meter dash (23.70). The AU men placed third in the 4-by-400 meter relay. Sophomore Kate Ciccone (Ithaca, NY/Brooktondale) was the top performer for the AU women's team, finishing third in the 1000-meter run (3:20.28).
