Senior guard Melanie Jackson (Andover, NY/Wellsville) scored a game-high 22 points on 9-of-18 shooting and grabbed seven rebounds to pace the Lady Saxons (2-0, 0-0 Empire 8). Sophomore point guard Lyndsay Murphy (Almond, NY/Hornell) and junior forward Libby Meier (Rochester, NY/Greece Odyssey) also scored in double figures for AU, with 14 and 10 points, respectively, with each pulling down seven rebounds. Murphy added three assists and a pair of steals, while junior forward Alysha Dias (Rochester, NY/Greece Olympia) had nine points to go with a team-high eight boards. Host Keuka (0-2) was paced by Brittany Schrock, with 13 points and Angela Viggiani with six points, a game-high 10 rebounds, and a pair of blocked shots. Alfred is in action again on Saturday, Nov. 22, at 8 p.m. against host Susquehanna University in the first round of the Susquehanna Tournament. Rutgers-Newark and McDaniel play in Saturday's other first-round contest, at 6 p.m. The consolation is set for 1 p.m. Sunday and the championship game follows at 3 p.m. The AU women's and men's teams play their season home opener on Tuesday, Nov. 25, at 6 p.m. and 8 p.m., respectively, at the McLane Center.
