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Nancy Hanks calling hours

Nancy Hanks, a longtime assistant in Alfred University's dining services, passed away on Tuesday, July 17, at Strong Memorial Hospital in Rochester after a brief illness. She was 62.

Nancy, who worked at Alfred University for nearly 40 years, was part of an AU legacy. Her mother, Elizabeth "Jean" Hanks, worked for the University for 50 years, and her father, Gerald Hanks, was a 1953 AU graduate and a Saxon football player in the early 1950s.

She is survived her longtime companion, Ed Ellington of Thatcherville; two sisters, Barb (Pat) McPoland of Greenville, SC, and Marilyn (Bill) Weidman of Spring Hill, TN.; several nieces and nephews; two great-nieces and one great-nephew. In addition to her parents, she was predeceased by her brother, Bill Hanks.

The family will receive friends on Friday, July 20, from 3 to 6 p.m. at the Dagon Funeral Home, 38 Church St. in Hornell. A Mass of Christian Burial will be celebrated at 11 a.m. on Saturday, July 21, at St. Brendan's Church in Almond, with burial in Woodlawn Cemetery, Almond.
