As one strategy to improve mobility services in Allegany County, the Allegany County Transportation Task Force is pleased to announce the launch of the Wellsville Express, a continuous loop of service throughout the township of Wellsvillek.

The Wellsville Express will run Monday-Friday from 10 a.m-4 p.m. with unlimited access throughout the day with the following fare structure:

Daily Standard Fare \$1 Seniors Age 60 & Older \$.50 Route Deviation\* \$3 Children Under Age 6 Free

\* In compliance with ADA requirements, Access Allegany will deviate from the route no more than 3/4 of a mile. Requests must be received two full business days in advance by calling 585.593.1738.
