Junior center Kylene Knoll (Elmira, NY/Elmira Free Academy) was one point shy of a double double, finishing with nine points and 11 rebounds, while senior guard Michelle Kelly (Levittown, NY/General Douglas MacArthur) netted 11 points to go along with a team-high four assists. Junior guard Patricia Affeldt (Horseheads, NY/Horseheads) chipped in with seven points and senior forward Colleen Lyons (Oakfield, NY/Oakfield-Alabama) grabbed seven rebounds and made a free-throw with four seconds left to secure the win for AU. Leading the way for Keuka (7-7) was junior forward Lindsay Baker (Scranton, PA/Scranton) who finished with a game-high 20 points and also grabbed seven boards. Senior forward Rachel Everson (Clifton Springs, NY/Midlakes) finished with 11 points, while sophomore guard Sarah Dorman (Batavia, NY/Elba) dished out seven assists.
