

AU faculty artists to exhibit at artSite in Wellsville

"Icyhot," an exhibition of work by faculty members Brian Arnold, Kim Beck, Andrew Deutsch, Michelle Lockwood, Darrin Martin, Lara Odell and Nick Tobier from the School of Art and Design at Alfred University, will open Friday, March 23, at 6 p.m. at artSite in The Davie Building, 114 North Main Street, Wellsville. The show, which is open to the public free of charge, will involve a variety of media, from traditional prints to sound and video. Arnold is an assistant professor of photography. Beck teaches printmaking as a visiting professor. Deutsch is an assistant professor of sonic arts; Michelle Lockwood, a visiting instructor of graphic design; Martin, a visiting professor of two-dimensional studies; and Tobier, assistant professor of freshman foundation. Odell is an AU alumna who is a visiting artist at Alfred under the Rockefeller grant that brings artists and scientists to Alfred to produce work through the Institute for Electronic Arts. ArtSite is a joint venture of the School of Art and Design, the Village of Wellsville and the Wellsville Chamber of Commerce. The not-for-profit gallery is dedicated to bringing art to the community.
